### 2nd March 2019 - 1m Intermediate Winter Show Jumping Qualifier at BCA

We had a wonderful and very proud day out with our very talented 1m Show Jumping Team at the intermediate Winter Show Jumping Qualifier held at BCA. All of our team rode beautifully in the small outdoor arena, which had some very tight turns for their big horses. Both Giselle Stent and Lynn Roberts went clear meaning our WSRC team finished the first 1m round on a total of 4 points putting us into the lead. The second round was held inside with jumps at 1.05m, Louise Hambleton rode an incredible clear round, getting an almighty cheer from the spectators when she finished! The rest of our team rode very well, with a couple of unfortunate knocks with our team finishing the day very proudly in 2nd place.

A huge congratulations to Louise for placing individually in 2nd place and qualifying for finals, and to Lynn placing 4th and Giselle for placing 5th and to Lauren for coming out and impressingly competing Drum for the first time in ages, jumping him over some huge fences. Thank you to our team for representing our Riding Club and to Christopher for giving up his Saturday to photograph our team and to Cathy, Britta and everyone's friends and family for supporting. ### 10th March 2019 - 80cm Arena Eventing Final at Aston LeWalls.

A huge congratulations to our amazing Arena Eventing Team, Tina Pendle, Louise Hollington, Megan Shenton and Tanya Creaye-Griffin for placing 10th at the Horse Quest Arena Eventing Chamionship at Aston LeWalls. We are extremely proud of all of our riders, firstly for winning the qualifier at Pyecombe and then for riding so well at Aston LeWalls placing in the final championship.

The course was made up of an arena of show jumps, followed immediately by a quick exit through a water complex into a separate arena full of XC jumps. We saw some incredible rounds from our WSRC riders and their horses. Our team were super speedy with Tina, Tanya and Louise riding faster than the optimum time and both Megan and Tina clearing the large joker fence perfectly at the end of their rounds.

Throughout the day we admired lots of very big professional looking horses from the other riding club teams, they had definitely sent the best of the best to compete. It is very impressive how well our team did

with two 14.1hh ponies, and the majority of our horses being veterans! It was an honour to watch our team ride so beautifully and fast!

We are very fortunate that our club are so friendly and supportive to each other. 10 of our riding club members went up to Aston for the whole weekend, taking over a local B&B and stable in preparation for the finals to help, drive, manage, groom, photograph and cheer on our team. It was a fun (wet, cold and muddy) weekend full of lots of laughter and support. ## Helpers for Summer 2019

The committee were overwhelmed with the response we got for helping out at the Good Friday show -Thank you to everyone that volunteered - we simply can't run this without you!

We are now going to be calling for helpers for the Dressage and Showing Show - set up on 13 July and show on the 14th, and also for the Showjumping and showing show planned for 1 September - we will need a big set up and take down party for this one. Both are once again at Whipley Manor this year. We would like to respectfully remind all members that it is a condition of membership that you help with a minimum of one event per year. We often see the same wonderful faces helping us - we do keep a bit of a list so please be aware that we may reach out and ask you directly to help if we don't get enough people come forward. We really cannot operate without our lovely members so please bear us in mind - when we ask we really do need you! Thank you.

## WSRC Points League

For those of you not familiar with this, points are awarded to any horse / rider combination who have entered Club closed or open competitions, or represented Club at qualifiers (as team members or individuals). Those representing Club un-mounted (for example, at the Area Quiz) also receive points. The number of points awarded is 6 for a 1st place, down to 1 for 6th. So, as an example, if someone wins a class & also comes 3rd in another class, they will score 6 for their win plus 4 for their 3rd place, giving them 10 points for that competition.

The Club awards trophies (presented at the AGM each November) for this League as follows:

- The Club Points Shield for the Senior member with the most points at the end of the year
- The Reserve Points award for the runner-up
- The Tom Trophy (kindly donated by Helen Kendall) for the Senior member over 59 years of age with the most points over the year
- The Junior Points Trophy for the Junior with the most points over the year.

However, please note **trophies will only be awarded to those who have also helped at at least one Club event during the year** (which is, after all, a condition of Club membership). If the member leading on points has not helped, the relevant trophy will be awarded to the next eligible member down the points list.
