BRIDLEWAYS REPORT

Downs Link Bridleway 252 nr Lockner Holt, Chilworth

I previously reported about the building of a short section of brick wall right on the edge of this path and the concern that this might have encroached on the bridleway. James Browne the Rights of Way Officer has now investigated and this is his response after his site visit:

I visited the site and then wrote to the landowner who was undertaking these works to make him aware that a member of the public had made a complaint about the extent of the works. I was not convinced from my earlier site visit that this was an outright encroachment. I arranged to meet the landowner on site, where he had pegged out the extent of his boundary. This extends out further than you might have considered, at least to the toe of the very slight boundary bank. Although the new garage wall is set at a skew it was within the landowners curtilage. I do not propose therefore to take any further action in this matter.

A second problem on this path was the loose and broken wire fencing that borders the bridleway and which for a short distance divides the bridleway and the footpath. James Browne has done what he said he would do i.e. the fencing has been repaired between the bridlepath and the footpath and the fencing along the adjacent house drive has been removed.

Bridleway 232 , Chilworth, off Sample Oak Lane

I am pleased to say that the fallen trees have been removed and the path is now open.

Alleged Public Bridleway at Manor Farm from East Shalford Lane to Halfpenny Lane

I am pleased to pass on the news that the Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State accepted the evidence of past equestrian use of this path. He confirmed the Order which will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by adding a public bridleway and upgrading a public footpath to a public bridleway. The full report is available on Surrey County Councils web site should you wish to read it in full.

17 June (tbc) – **National Novice Dressage** (teams of 4 only, Seniors only, all Prelim. tests), **L&SE Dressage** (teams of 4 only, Seniors (may include 1 Junior), Prelim. tests) & **L&SE Riding Test** (teams only, Seniors only (may include 1 Junior)) – Bookham RC field

30 June – National & L&SE Dressage to Music (teams & individuals, Seniors & Juniors, freestyle, pas seul, pas de deux & costume)

Venue Etiquette

WSRC is fortunate to have access to some wonderful venues for our instruction programme, some of which are small private yards, unused to the arrival of hoards of new WSRC faces/animals! There are a few simple things we would ask everyone taking part in our instruction to adhere to, to make sure we remain welcome at our venues:

-  please only WALK your horse when at other venues - especially in private yards - unless you are in the school/training area. Please do not trot or canter your horses outside of these areas, so we can avoid upsetting other animals at the venues
-  if your horse leaves droppings, please make every attempt to clear up after them – most venues will have shovels/skips/forks available for your use please don't assume that someone will clear up after your horse in the school - at the end of a lesson, please make sure the school is left clean
-  if you plan to bring spectators along please check with the organiser that this is OK with the venue
-  please check with the venue organiser if dogs are allowed, and if so all dogs should always be kept on leads at all times and any mess left should be removed.
-  absolutely no smoking at any of the venues - by you or your spectators/visitors.

Booking Instruction

Training clinics will now be organised by Lisa Fahy unless otherwise stated.

-  As previously, all requests for bookings will be allocated in strict order of them being received. Places are only secured on receipt of money. Places must be confirmed within 5 days, by sending your cheques for each that session.
-  Cheques should be made payable to WSRC.
-  Please note that due to the high demand for instruction your place WILL NOT be held without a cheque.
-  If the instruction is already full do leave your details with the organiser. Waiting lists are held and you will be contacted if a space becomes available.
-  If you find that you aren't able to take part in a lesson that you've booked please let the organiser know as soon as possible. The more notice you give the more chance there is of us finding someone to take your place. If we can't find someone to take your place your cheque will be cashed.

Hinda Inglis BHSII – Flatwork Instruction – Saturday 12th May – 10.00am prompt either ½ hour individual or 1 hour pair

Hinda is a BHSII qualified instructor who is well known to many of our Club members. She managed to combine sympathetic and informative instruction with a great deal of fun and humour – so you won't notice how hard you've worked until afterwards!

Venue : Hurtmore Cottage, Rowe Lane, Farley Heath, Surrey (by kind permission of Pami Nixon)

There is no parking at Hurtmore Cottage. Please park at the Roman Temple.

Cost of lessons : ½ hour private lesson £ 20 / 1 hour pair lesson £ 20 each.

Alex Cookson – BHSI Dressage Clinic – Thursdays 10th/24th May and Thursdays 14th/21st June 2012 – lessons starting at 11.00am prompt either ½ hour individual or ¾ hour pair.

*Alex Cookson BHSI : Director & Senior Instructor of the Training Teachers of Tomorrow Trust. Alex began her career as a three-day event rider. Now specialising in Dressage, she has competed and trained many horses, including her own, up to Intermediare I level. **Just because Alex is part of the TTT these lessons are open to all and she is not expecting “posh” horses or riders – so come on give it a go – it’s nice to have new instructors AND YOU’LL STAY DRY AS IT’S INSIDE!***

Venue : East Whitley Farm, East Whitley Lane, Shamley Green, Surrey GU5 0TE (by kind permission of Alex Cookson)

There is plenty of parking on site. Please follow directions to TTT Horsebox Parking and then follow the drive around to the farm gates. You will see the indoor school in front of you and signs pointing you to the outdoor school. Warm up in the outdoor school and then knock on indoor school door at your allocated time.

Cost of lessons : ½ hour private lesson £ 30 / ¾ hour pair lesson £ 25 each

Lucy Fisher – Showing Workshop – 26th May 11.00 prompt for 1½ hours - Groups of 4

Lucy Fisher from Loxwood has been showing horses all her life. From ponies through to Riding Horses, Hacks, Cobs, Hunters, even Ladies Hunters (side saddle), Lucy has ridden them all. In 2011 she qualified two horses for Horse of the Year Show - a large Riding Horse and a Heavyweight Cob, who was placed

8th. Lucy is noted for the stunning turnout of her horses and will share with Members tips and learnings from her years of showing.

This workshop is aimed at those wanting to do in-hand and ridden showing classes. *Please come to the workshop as you would go to a show class (attire, tack, turnout). The first part of the workshop will be on foot with your horse and will include learning how to present your horse to the conformation judge. The group will then ride the class as if it was a show class and Lucy will give help, guidance, and feedback.* There will be plenty of time to discuss how things should be done and you will learn lots of “tricks of the trade” to make you stand out for all the right reasons in the show ring!

Please tell us what type of horse you will be bringing (i.e. cob, hack, riding horse, hunter, etc) when booking this workshop. If you have a friend/helper who grooms for you at shows please ask them to join you as well so they can learn more about the groom's role.

Venue : Whitley Manor Farm, Bramley, Guildford, Surrey GU5 0LL (by kind permission of Lisa Fahy and Adrian Elliott)

There is also plenty of parking on site. Once off A281 follow the drive all the way to the bottom (½ mile) – do not turn off to Animal Feed or Wine Shop! Take right hand fork and park in front of and to side of barns on your right. The outdoor school is behind the large barn. **Please do not drive on grass going down the main drive – passing spaces at top, middle & bottom.** You can also hack to Whitley Manor Farm and get off the "Old Railway Line" by the road bridge at Run Common. Just go up the bank (on your left if coming from Cranleigh or right if coming from Bramley!) Go along the path and through the little gate on your left. Keep to the farm track for ¾ mile through wood and along fields. Once out on tarmac drive turn left keep going past horses fields. Take the right hand fork and the outdoor school is behind the large barn on your right.

Cost of session : £ 20 per rider £ 5 per groom

Fiona Breach – Show Jumping Instruction – Date & time in June to be confirmed – keep an eye out on the WSRC Web Site – 1 hour lessons – Groups of 4.

There will be an up-to 2' group and a '3" and higher group. Fiona has been working with some of the WSRC SJ Team and is willing to spread her knowledge to anyone else who wants to leave the ground on purpose!
