- Section 1A Dressage: Walk & Trot test B (2009) Show Jumping: Cross poles up to 55 cm
Section 1B Dressage: Walk & Trot test B ONLY
Section 1C Show Jumping: Cross poles up to 55 cm ONLY

Class 2

- Section 2A Dressage: Prelim 18 (2002 revised) Show Jumping: jumps between 60-70 cm
Section 2B Dressage: Prelim 18 ONLY
Section 2C Show Jumping: jumps between 55-70 cm ONLY

Class 3

- Section 3A Dressage: PYO Prelim 12 (2005) **OR** Novice 27 (2007)
Show Jumping: Jumps between 70-85 cm
Section 3B Dressage Prelim 12 or Novice 27 (judged as combined class)
Section 3C Show Jumping: Jumps between 70-85 cm

Please add into the comments box which dressage test you wish to do.

Section A in each class is judged and scored as a combined training event.

All dressage and jumping is on grass arenas by kind permission of Will Fahy and Adrian Elliott at Whipleby Manor.

Class entries:

Section A in each class: WSRC members £10. Friends £12.

Section B or C in each class: WSRC members £6. Friends £7.

Entries for the Combined training and dressage only sections must be made in advance and will close on the Thursday prior to the competition. Limited entries for the show jumping only section will be taken on the day and will close 30 minutes prior to the class starting.

Rules and Regulations

1. All events will be run in accordance with the current British Horse Society Riding Clubs Rule book. Callers will be allowed for ALL dressage tests.
2. A copy of the rule book will be available with the secretary on the day.
3. Qualified Club first aiders will be present on the day but competitors are reminded that they take part at their own risk and that any competitor suffering an injury or a fall should report to the secretary.
4. The decision of the judge is final. Objections must be made in writing to the show secretary within 30 minutes of the incident, accompanied by a deposit of £10 that will be returned if the objection is upheld.
5. Neither the organisers nor the owners of the venue accept liability for any claims in respect of injury or damage to any person, animal or property however caused.
6. Hats must be worn at all times when mounted.....
7. Misuse of spurs or whips will incur elimination. On blatant use of bad language or aggressive behaviour a competitor or spectator will be asked to leave the show. All competitors must act in a safe and responsible manner at all times.
8. In the event of the show being cancelled 50% of entry fees will be returned to all competitors.
9. Please clean up after your horses, humans and picnics! Take everything home with you! Dogs must be kept on short leads at all times.
