Annual WSRC Summer Day Camp

As you will have hopefully seen by email, we have announced the instructors booked for our Summer Day Camp at Munstead on 30th June 2018. We are pleased to confirm that Hinda Inglis, Sarah-Jane Hornsby and Eloise Mayhead will all be joining us on the day. If you haven't got your entry in yet, then please do so asap so that we can arrange the groups accordingly. Details are included in the timetable of events below. Dressage and Showing Show

We were worried that any dressage divas out there might be missing the dressage series this Summer, so we are putting on a show at Whipley Manor on Saturday 14th July 2018. We are running Intro, Prelim and Novice dressage classes, all on grass. A great opportunity to come and practice in a grass arena, particularly if you are looking to compete at the L&SE Dressage Qualifier at Pachesham the following week. We also have several show classes, designed specifically for people to have fun and give it a go – you don't need to be any kind of showing expert for this! And just to add to the fun, we will be arranging that you can "have a go at Trec"...a taster course of Trec obstacles...a chance to see what Trec involves or just see how your pony responds to the different challenges presented to him or her. Whatever your level of riding, there is hopefully something for everyone to have a go at – please come and support us. LONDON AND SOUTH EAST SHOW JUMPING QUALIFIER - Saturday 16th June 2018 at Bookham Riding Club field

We are looking for volunteers to form part of a show jump team for the L&SE SJ qualifier on Saturday 16th June. It is teams of 4 with the best 3 scores to count. The 1st round is 80cms and the 2nd is 85cms. Anyone interested please contact jennytully2000@yahoo.co.uk by 10th June.

TEAMS OF THREE SHOW JUMPING - Hickstead 29th July 2018

This team jumping event is held at the Royal International Horse Show at Hickstead. The teams are made up of three horses and riders; one Novice combination jumping 85cm, one intermediate combination jumping 95cm and one Open combination jumping 1.05m. Each combination rides one round against the clock. The team with the fewest combined faults and fastest combined time wins. It is a long day but great fun and worth it!

BLENHEIM EVENTERS CHALLENGE - Thursday 13th September 2018

We are looking for volunteers to ride as part of a team of 4 in the Eventer Challenge at 90cms held as part of Blenheim Palace International Horse Trial. If anyone is interested in becoming a potential member of the Blenheim squad, please register your interest with me now. This is a "Derby" style competition with a section of 8-10 show jumps leading to 6-8 efforts over portable and fixed cross country fences, finishing with a show jump. The max height of the show jumps and cross country fences will be 0.95m.

There are a variety of rules but the key one is that horse and rider combinations must have completed competently at BE90/BRC HT90 as a bare minimum and the rider must be a member of BE, BHS, PC or have their own 3rd party insurance.

This event is well up to height and the fences are challenging, so it is not for the faint hearted! But if you are interested please contact <u>jennytully2000@yahoo.co.uk</u> as soon as possible.

Munstead is a great place to learn and there are a couple of logs on the ground, a number of inviting fences on the new 60cm course, a very small side to the steps and an easy to enter small water. However, if you think this is really not for you please add: I would prefer not to do cross country and we will endeavour to add a further flatwork session

Please note that body protectors must be worn on the cross country course. Further details regarding arrangements for lunch will be provided in due course noting we plan that everyone will be asked to bring a dish for sharing on the day. We look forward to seeing you for a fun filled day!
