WSRC AGM Friday 23 November 2018

Biomechanics Clinic with Lottie Betchley – Saturday 27th October at Whipley Manor Farm.

Lottie (from CHAPPS Physio) is a Chartered Physiotherapist specialising in the equine - rider partnership. Lottie provides physiotherapy for both horse and rider, as well as rider pilates and biomechanics sessions. Lottie works closely with a wide range of horse and rider partnerships to optimise their biomechanics, function and performance.

The session will include:

- ~ A ridden assessment of your posture and position.
- ~ Identification, discussion and correction of the weaknesses or asymmetries.
- ~ Practice of ridden exercises for improved symmetry and balance.

Following the session you will be sent an individualised:

- ~ Detailed report of the findings and recommendations for your riding.
- ~ Non-ridden pilates based exercise programme.

Cost:

- ~ individual session 30 minutes (£55)
- ~ individual 60 minutes (£95)
- ~ shared session (2 riders) 60 minutes (£55 pp)
