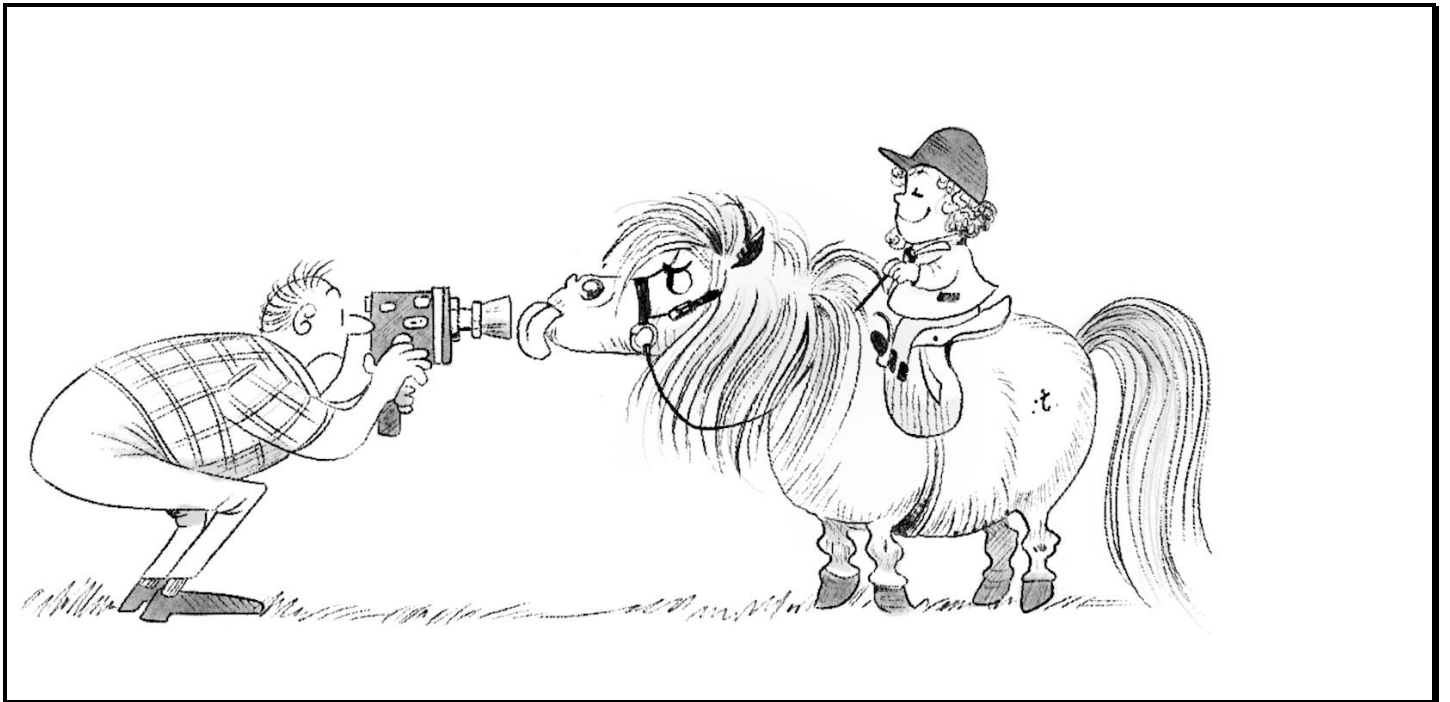

## Show Classes:

### Ring 1 Morning: In-hand showing classes.

Ring starts at **10.30 a.m.** Classes will follow on – please allow **approx.** 30 minutes per class.

- Class 1: Have a go in-hand showing (for novice horse, pony or handler) - combination not to have been placed 1st in any in-hand class previously. Special rosettes to best 2, 3 and 4 year old horse / pony.
- Class 2: In-hand Coloured – horse or pony, any unusual colour (including palomino, dun, roan etc.).
- Class 3: In-hand Mountain and Moorland (open to any M&M breed, pure or part-bred).
- Class 4: In-hand Horse – Hunter, Hack, Riding Horse, TB, Cob etc.
- Class 5: In-hand Veterans (over 16 years) - special rosette to oldest horse / pony, and oldest horse / handler combination.

**In-hand championship** to follow – for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> from each of the above classes. Championship rosette and sash to champion, plus rosette to reserve.

### Ring 1 Afternoon:

Not to start before **1.30 p.m.**

- Class 6: Fancy dress – open to all, seniors and juniors, in-hand, ridden or on lead-rein.
- Class 7: Handsomest Gelding / Prettiest Mare - in-hand, ridden or on lead-rein. Class will be split if entries allow – please state “gelding” or “mare” when entering.
- Class 8: Family Horse / Pony – ridden. May be shared between junior and adult rider as part of individual show.

### Ring 2: Ridden Showing Classes.

Ring starts at **9:30 a.m.** Classes will follow on – please allow **approx.** 45 minutes per class.

- Class 9: Have a go ridden showing (for novice horse, pony or rider) – combination not to have been placed 1<sup>st</sup> in any ridden showing class previously. Walk and trot only; canter in individual show if rider wishes. Lead rein welcome but class will be judged as a whole.
- Class 10: Ridden Mountain & Moorland (open to any M&M breed, pure or part-bred)
- Class 11: Ridden Horse - Hunter, Hack, Riding horse, TB, Cobs etc. Judged on type, manners and way of going. Judge will not ride.
- Class 12: Ridden Coloured – horse or pony, any unusual colour (including palomino, dun, roan etc.).
- Class 13: Riding Club Horse / Pony – to be ridden in a snaffle. May be required to jump a small fence.
- Class 14: Ridden Veteran (over 16 years) – special rosette to oldest horse / pony, and oldest horse / rider combination.

**Ridden championship** to follow – for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> from each of the above classes. Championship rosette and sash to champion, plus rosette to reserve.

**Ring 3: Clear Round Show Jumping.** Entries on the day only.

Can be led / assisted. Suitable for all abilities; jumps will start as cross-poles and be raised during the day depending on demand. Any related distances will be based on horse strides.

**Ring 4: Handy Pony.** Entries on the day only.

A series of obstacles that can be done mounted.

Riders may be led or have an assistant on foot alongside, but the rider must complete the obstacle themselves.

Points will be awarded out of 10 for each obstacle for completion of task, style and calmness.

Rosette to all for completion of course, plus for 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> based on points scored.

### **Directions to the show ground:**

Heath Farm is located on the B2130 Godalming to Cranleigh Road, just outside Godalming (sign-posted to Cranleigh and Winkworth Arboretum). For sat nav users please use postcode **GU7 1XA**, Grid Reference **SU983431**. We strongly advise that for ease of access you approach Heath Farm from the Godalming direction as opposed to the Hascombe / Cranleigh direction, as the turn into Heath Farm from the Cranleigh end of the B2130 is blind, and too tight for a lorry.

At the pedestrian crossing by the church on the B2130, slow down, go over one more speed bump and turn left into Heath Lane (IGNORE SAT NAV as it will take you straight on). It is very narrow (but plenty big enough for a horsebox) and is very easy to go straight past. Go down the lane and take the first left into Heath Farm.

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ALL WSRC EVENTS.**

The venue owners have requested horses / ponies are not left unattended when tied outside horseboxes or trailers.

Please do not muck out lorries or trailers onto the show ground.

1. All events will be run in accordance with the current BHS Riding Clubs Rules Book. A copy of the relevant Rules Book will be available at the Show Secretary's Office on the day of the show.
2. The decisions of the judges are final.
3. Objections must be made in writing within 30 minutes of the incident, accompanied by a deposit of £20, which will be returned if the objection is upheld.
4. Neither the organisers nor the owners of the venue accept liability for any claims in respect of injury or damage to any person, animal or property, how-so-ever caused.
5. The organisers reserve the right to change judges or appoint substitutes and to amend the schedule as necessary.
6. The organisers reserve the right to reject or cancel any entry made by any persons or cancel any class (refunding all fees paid).
7. Entry fees must be paid at time of entry. No entries will be refunded without a Veterinary Surgeon's or Doctors certificate.
8. **DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON SHORT LEADS AT ALL TIMES.**
9. A riding or skull cap complying with at least PAS 015 or higher must be worn at all times when mounted with chin-strap fastened.
10. Misuse of spurs or whips will incur elimination. Use of bad language by a competitor will result in them being asked to leave the showground.
11. All competitors must act in a safe and responsible manner at all times.
12. In the event of the show being cancelled, entry fees will be returned (less £2 per competitor to cover administration expenses).
13. All horses and ponies ridden in classes must be 4 years of age or over.
14. Please be advised that photography and/or filming will be taking place at our events. If you do not wish to appear in any images captured, please inform the secretary so that we can take appropriate steps to ensure you are not included. The photographs / film could potentially be included in publicity sent to the local press or in WSRC / BRC Area 11 Riding Club promotional materials in the future and may also be published on the WSRC Riding Club website and social media.
